Foolishness: Naïve, Defiant and Reckless, Godless

Filled with the Father's essence to reconcile – to what length will you go for reconciliation?

Through the ultimate sacrifice through ultimate shame

Once outsiders because of your goals and focus Now insiders: without blemish-free from accusation If you continue in faith – and do not move from your hope Paul has bought into the reconciliation project: Rejoices in suffering for their sake, <u>Church, Body</u>

Body issues, Body image

- 2 Corinthians 4:13-16 Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.
