


Do you have what you want?








Eccl 5:17 eat in darkness, with great frustration, affliction and anger.

¹⁵ You will plant but not harvest; you will press olives but not use the oil, you will crush grapes but not drink the wine.




Luke 12:16-21



Status: A criminal's torture


Freedom: Nail to a tree of curse
